## **BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS**

### **Resolution**

WHEREAS, The County of Blue Earth employ staff to perform State mandated services to the residents of Blue Earth County and;

WHEREAS, Governor Tim Walz has issued Emergency Executive Order 20-20 Directing Minnesotans to Stay at Home effective March 27, 2020 at 11:59 PM through April 10, 2020 in response to the community spread of COVID-19, and;

WHEREAS, Executive Order 20-20 lists Exemptions for Critical Sectors including healthcare and public health; law enforcement, public safety, and first responders; water and wastewater; transportation and logistics; communications and information technology; and other community-based government operations, and;

WHEREAS, Executive Order 20-20 references the U.S. Department of Homeland Security Guidance on the Essential Critical Infrastructure Workforce: Ensuring Community and National Resilience in COVID-19 Response which identifies workers who conduct a range of services that are essential to continued critical infrastructure viability, and;

WHEREAS, Executive Order 20-20 states “All political subdivisions of the State will determine the minimum personnel necessary to maintain these governmental operations”;

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED the Blue Earth County Board of Commissioners hereby determines that all services provided by the County will continue subject to those services being delivered utilizing social distancing best practices;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED Blue Earth County employees deemed able to deliver services through telework options are directed to work with Blue Earth County Administration, or designee, to comply with Executive Order 20-20;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED Blue Earth County buildings will remain closed to the public through April 12, 2020 or until Blue Earth County Administration determines they may be opened to the public.
